Searching the Catalogs: LRC Catalog, Circuit, ILL

LRC Catalog

- The Legal Research Center's online catalog links to materials held at the LRC and the Main Library (Copley)
- The catalog can be used to find not just materials in our print collection, but also to access e-books and electronic databases

- SICE stands for Sistema de Informacion sobre Comercio Exterior. It is the information arm for the Organization of American States (OAS) Member States.
- SICE includes texts of trade agreements and BITs in force in North and South America.
