



Limitations on WestlawNext while in school

- Attorneys use free sites to supplement their WL/Lexis research
 - Clients don't want to pay for "research"
 - Lexis/WL may not have what you need

What can you expect to find?


Language Access Task Force Members



Google Scholar

- Quick and easy
- "How cited" feature allows you to find similar cases
 - NOT a substitute for Shepard's or KeyCite
 - Does not work for unpublished cases
- Coverage
 - State appellate and supreme court decisions (since 1950)
 - Federal district, appellate, tax, and bankruptcy decision (since 1923)
 - U.S. Supreme court decisions (since 1791)
 - No codes, court rules, etc.
