

New First-Year Parking Permit Process

Effective July 15, 2026

Qualifications

To be eligible for a first-year parking permit, you must provide:

- Proof of off-campus employment within a 50-mile radius of USD
- Current proof of income dated within the last 30 days (pay stub required)
- Employer contact information for employment verification or transfer confirmation

Situations That Do Not Qualify

The following reasons are not eligible for a parking permit:

- Picking up prescriptions
- Grocery shopping
- Caregiving responsibilities (including nannying, caring for grandparents, or caring for parents)
- Sports practices or competitions
- Internships
- New employment without proof of income (applications may be submitted only after a current pay stub is available)
- Self-employment or 1099 income, including:
 - Door Dash
 - Uber
 - Online sales or resale activities

We recognize that students have a variety of personal, family, religious, and extracurricular commitments. However, parking permit eligibility is limited to students who meet the established employment-based criteria outlined above.
