## **Assessment Overview & Results Summary**

**College/School:** College of Arts and Sciences

Measures Used: The English Department draws information about student achievement

in the major from end-of-the-semester papers in select upper-division courses and occasionally lower-division gateway courses to the major.

Process for Interpretation of Evidence:

Faculty members meet to discuss and share their mutual understanding of the importance that a given learning outcome plays in a student's overall development as a major. The faculty developed a rubric based

on those created by the Association of American Colleges and Universities; determined a benchmark for student achievement; developed a committee of 2-3 people to read and score randomly selected essays (although faculty occasionally read all of them); and shared the results in a department meeting so that discussion could

take place.
