Results Summary and Continuous Improvement Actions for AY 2020-2021: In Spring 2021, the MS in Executive Leadership students were assessed on their applied leadership skills by submitting a case study where students are rated as Excellent, Satisfactory, or Poor. The criterion for this assessment was as follows:

- Analyzing Leadership Challenges 100% of students scored excellent, 0% scored satisfactory; 0% scored poor
- Leadership for Innovation 80% of students scored excellent, 20% scored satisfactory; 0% scored poor
- Implications and Integration management 100% of students scored excellent, 0% scored satisfactory; 0% scored poor

Count: 20 students

Benchmark: 75% of the students are expected to score at or above the Satisfactory level, which indeed happened this year.
