Process for Interpretation of Evidence:

Data is collected by Office of Accreditation and Assessment.
Assessment results are initially reviewed by Assessment Faculty
Committees; these are divided into 7 groups, namely: Global Business
Practices Skills, Writing Skills, Presentation Skills, Leadership Skills,
Critical Analysis Skills, Technology Skills, and Ethics Skills. Each group
consists of three School of Business faculty. The group interprets the
data and make recommendations. The Assurance of Learning (AoL)
committee (comprised of Associate Deans, Academic Directors, and
Department Chairs) is responsible overall for implementation and final

recommendation.

How Findings are Used:

- ✓ Changes to curriculum/pedagogy
- ✓ Changes to assessment methods
- ✓ Increased faculty professional development

Results Summary and Continuous Improvement Actions for AY 2020-2021:

In Spring 2021, Leadership and Interpersonal skills were assessed in MGMT-300 courses in a group project. Students were scored using a 4-point rubric in the following areas (benchmark included):

- Confidence in their abilities = 80% of the students should be proficient (3) or higher;
- Balance interpersonal relations and task = 80% of the students should be acceptable (2) or higher;
- Consider others' suggestions = 80% of the students should be acceptable (2) or higher;
- Listening skills = 80% of the students should be acceptable (2) or higher.

RESULTS - IB majors scored:

- Confidence in their abilities: Mean-3.67; Std. Dev. 0.50;
 Percent 92%
- Balances interpersonal relations and tasks: Mean-3.78; Std. Dev. - 0.44; Percent - 94%
