Results Summary and Continuous Improvement Actions for AY 2020-2021:

Our Plan of Action Document completed by faculty, students and staff in Spring 2021 indicated that several steps needed to be taken to address issues related to DEI to improve program quality. A steering committee was formed to guide 4 sub-committees to analyze practices that would address: 1) student retention and success: (2) school climate, culture, and community engagement; (3) faculty retention and success; (4) teaching and pedagogy.
