THE ARRIVAL AND MOVE-IN PROCESS

On Saturday, August 31, please plan to move in between 10 a.m. and noon. All transfer students will receive their move-in and orientation materials at Manchester Village before proceeding to their residence halls.

It is important that you park in the designated areas and follow the directions of all USD staff, volunteers and posted signs. Welcome Team members will assist you in moving into your rooms. Please label your belongings with your last name, building and room number.

Residential transfer students will be living in one of four residential areas, Manchester Village Apartments, Valley Apartments, Alcalá Vistas Apartments and University Terrace Apartments.

All campus directions will be reviewed at the Manchester Village check-in location with new students and their families. Staff and student leaders will be able to answer your questions about how to navigate campus, your move-in and orientation upon arrival. Residential Life can also address questions ahead of time.

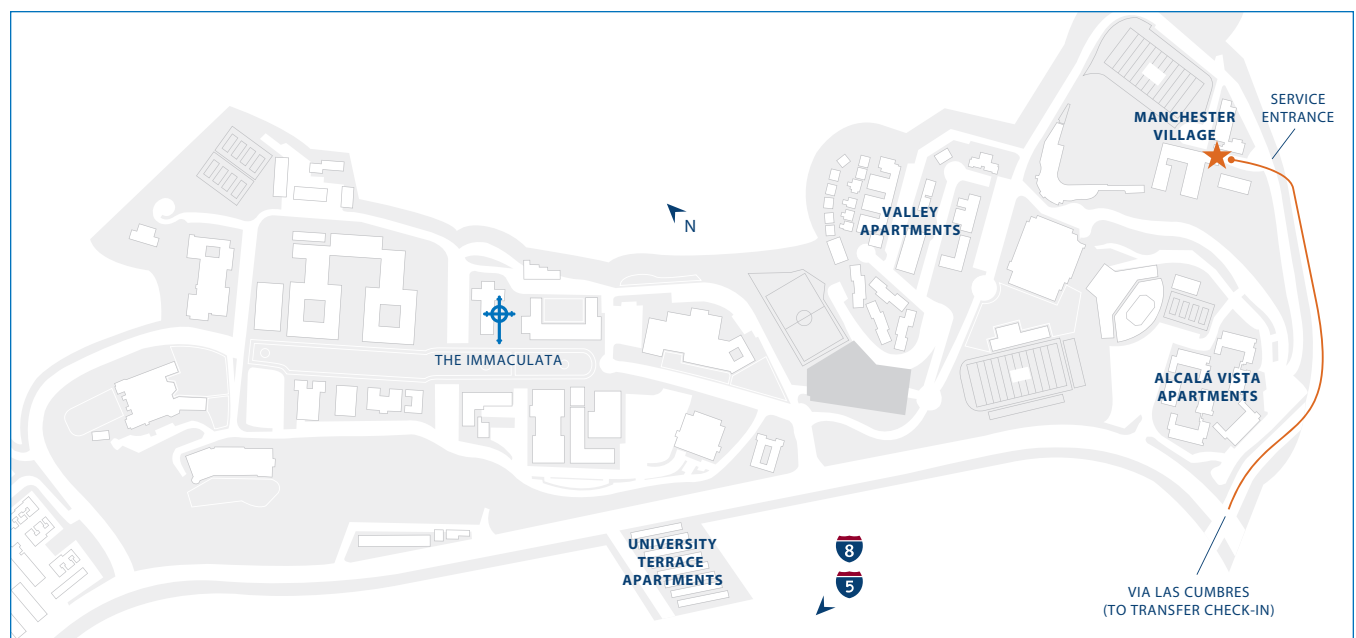

Parking



Your Move-In Day unloading and parking pass is attached in the email with the Arrival and Move-In Memo. Print out the free Move-In Day Pass and complete the information listed (name, assigned time and cell phone number). A Move-In Day Pass is required for all vehicles unloading and parking for move-in during new student and parent orientation from Aug. 31 through Sept. 3. Once your pass is printed, post it in a visible manner in the lower driver-side corner of your windshield prior to arriving on campus.

Students wishing to park a vehicle on campus after Sept. 3 must obtain a campus parking permit from Parking Services.



Students who have been invited to and have RSVP'd for either the First-Generation Student and Family Lunch or the Black Student Welcome Reception will be assigned an early move-in time that does not conflict with these events. These students will receive instructions via email to access these passes.

Mailing Items Ahead

You can ship items ahead in order to assist with your move-in experience. All of your packages should be labeled as follows:

Packages can be picked up on Move-In Day, Saturday, Aug. 31, in the lot behind The Immaculata. Staff will help locate items and scan them to the recipient for a signature. Vehicles should come through the West Entrance, pull into the lot for loading then exit via the Main Entrance. Founders/Camino and Maher residents are encouraged to not drive because of their proximity to the lot. Dollies, hand carts and orange bins cannot be loaned out.

USD Mail Center

The USD Mail Center is open Monday through Thursday, Aug. 26-29, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Friday, Aug. 30 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturday, Aug. 31 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. It will be open Sunday from 8 a.m. to noon to answer any questions pertaining to mail policy and procedures as well as allow students to pick up any remaining packages.

Orders placed after Aug. 16 must be shipped to your campus unit address. Bed Bath & Beyond will also be on-campus Saturday, Aug. 31 from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., outside the Student Life Pavilion for last-minute shopping needs.

Make Your USD Move-In Green!

See the tips below to have a more sustainable move-in and help USD move closer to becoming a zero-waste campus. Visit the Sustainability website for more green tips.

- **Reuse your cardboard.** Store your boxes to use during move-out or recycle them in the blue recycling bins located near the residence hall.
- **Recycle.** Each room comes with a blue recycling bin. All recyclable items can go in the blue bin.
- **Reduce your energy consumption.** Coordinate with your roommate(s) to rent a refrigerator/microwave. Unplug your electronics when they are not in use and turn off the lights when leaving a room.
- **Bring your bags.** Use a reusable bag when you go shopping on and off campus. California law requires customers to pay \$0.10 per plastic bag (unless you bring your own bag and/or hand carry your items).
- **Buy green.** Stock up your room with green goodies, such as organic cotton sheets, chemical-free or recycled notebooks and environmentally friendly cleaning products.

MANCHESTER VILLAGE APARTMENTS MOVE-IN

Manchester Village

Step 1

- Turn north on Via Las Cumbres from Linda Vista Road in order to enter campus. Proceed through the service entrance on your left-hand side in front of Manchester Village.
- Park temporarily in the reserved spots around the entrance to Manchester Village.
- Report to the check-in table at Manchester Village to receive your Transfer Fall Orientation materials and your housing information to check in to your room.

Step 2

- Proceed to the Manchester Village structures by following Torero Way around Building 1 (the three-story building). Turn left and proceed into the structure.
- Please park your vehicle in the appropriate structure. Rooms ending in -01 through -15, turn left at the entrance to Building 1. Rooms ending in -21 through -40 go forward to the entrance to Building 2.
- Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings.

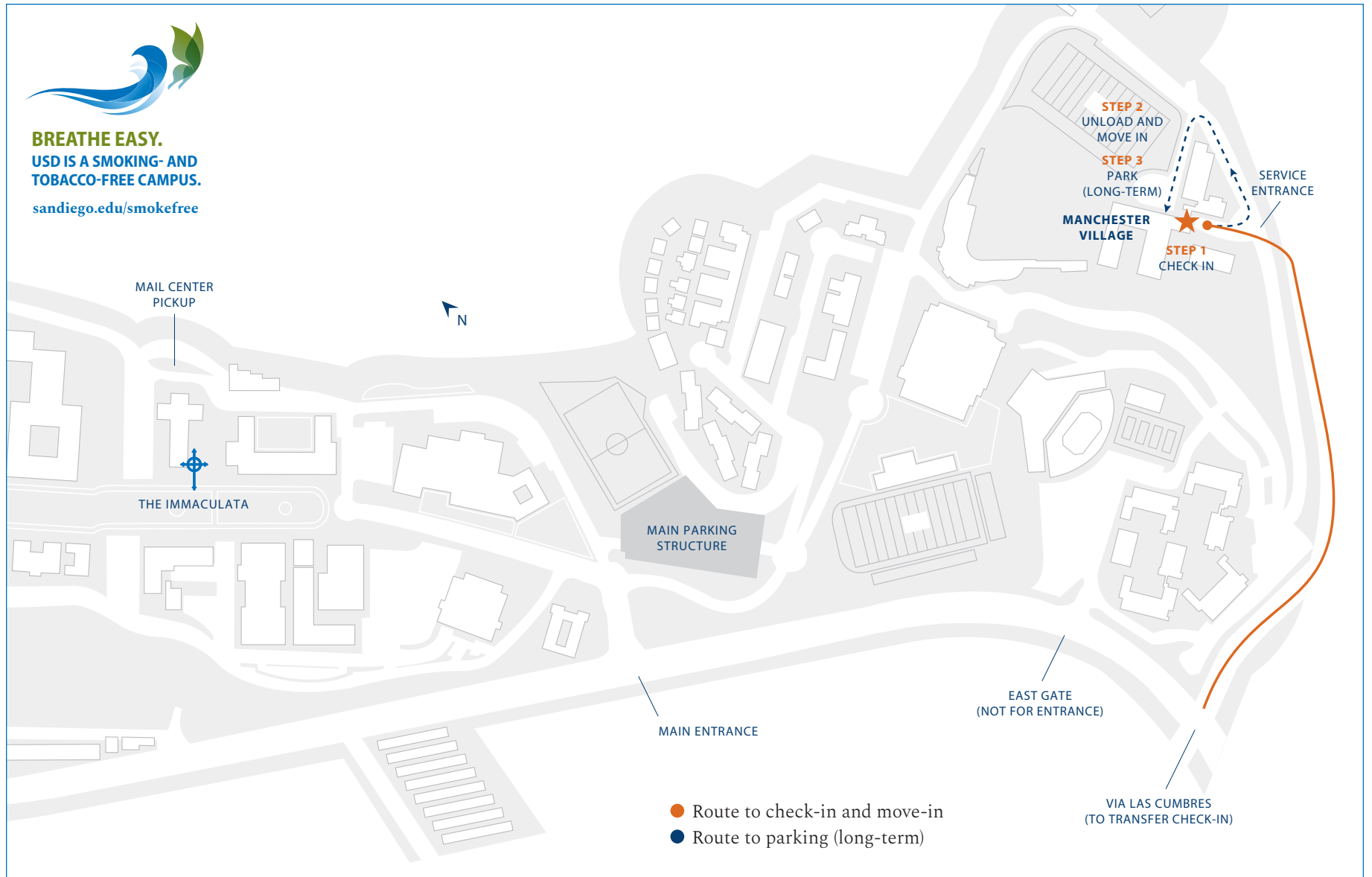
Step 3

- Long-term parking during Transfer Fall Orientation for Manchester Village residents is located in the structures under Buildings 1 and 2. Vehicles may also be parked in the Main Parking Structure or West Structure as needed during Transfer Fall Orientation.

VALLEY APARTMENTS MOVE-IN

San Buenaventura (San Buen)

Step 1

- Turn north on Via Las Cumbres from Linda Vista Road in order to enter campus. Proceed through the service entrance on your left-hand side in front of Manchester Village.
- Park temporarily in the reserved spots around the entrance to Manchester Village.
- Report to the check-in table at Manchester Village to receive your Transfer Fall Orientation materials and your housing information to check in to your room.

Step 2

- Proceed to the Valley Apartments by following Torero Way around Manchester Village and the athletic field. Manchester Village and the athletic field will be on your left.
- Turn right at San Buenaventura Way. Fowler Park will be on your left as you turn right.
- Follow San Buenaventura Way and parallel park to your right when directed by USD personnel. Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings.
- A driver will need to remain in each vehicle during the move-in process in order to maintain a smooth and timely experience for all.

Step 3

- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the Main Parking Structure (see map)*** and park in any available space. From there, you will be able to return to San Buenaventura.
- Long-term parking during Transfer Fall Orientation for San Buenaventura residents is located in the Main Parking Structure. The Main Parking Structure is accessible and is in close proximity to the San Buenaventura residence hall area.
- A resource desk for Valley Apartment residents and families will be located on the patio on the northwest end of San Antonio de Padua to assist you.

San Antonio de Padua (SAP)

Step 1

- Turn north on Via Las Cumbres from Linda Vista Road in order to enter campus. Proceed through the service entrance on your left-hand side in front of Manchester Village.
- Park temporarily in the reserved spots around the entrance to Manchester Village.
- Report to the check-in table at Manchester Village to receive your Transfer Fall Orientation materials and your housing information to check in to your room.

Step 2

- Proceed to the Valley Apartments by following Torero Way around Manchester Village and the athletic field. Manchester Village and the athletic field will be on your left.
- Turn right at San Buenaventura Way. Fowler Park will be on your left as you turn right.
- Follow San Buenaventura Way to the stop sign and turn left when directed by USD personnel.
- Turn left on Santa Paula Drive. Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings. Parking on Santa Paula Drive is parallel.
- A driver will need to remain in each vehicle during the move-in process in order to maintain a smooth and timely experience for all.

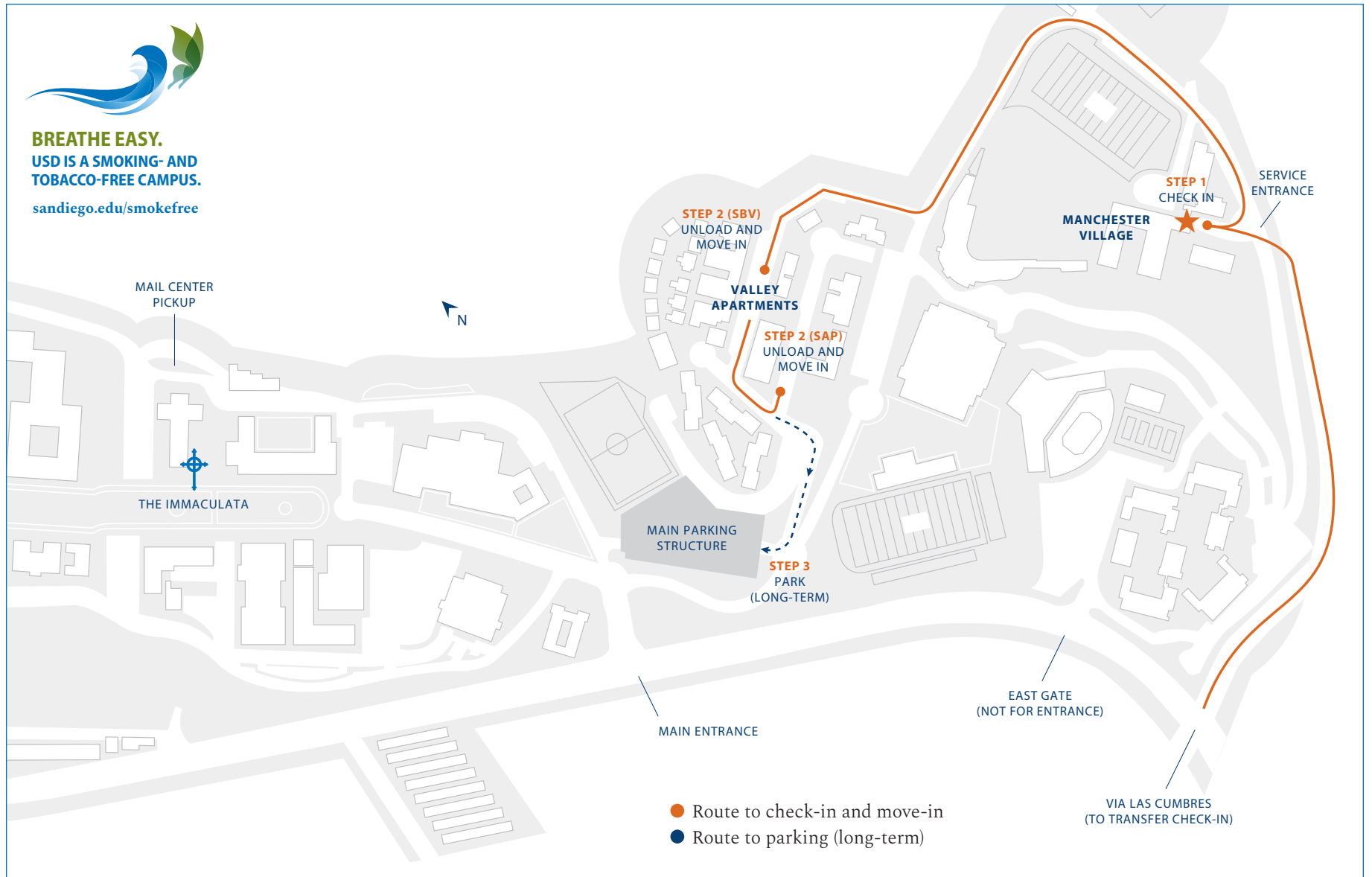
Step 3

- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the Main Parking Structure (see map)*** and park in any available space. From there, you will be able to return to San Antonio de Padua.
- Long-term parking during Transfer Fall Orientation for San Antonio de Padua residents is located in the Main Parking Structure. The Main Parking Structure is accessible and is in close proximity to the San Antonio de Padua residence hall area.
- A resource desk for Valley Apartment residents and families will be located on the patio on the northwest end of San Antonio de Padua to assist you.

ALCALÁ VISTAS APARTMENTS MOVE-IN

Alcalá Vistas (Palomar, Borrego, Cuyamaca and Laguna Halls)

Step 1

- Turn north on Via Las Cumbres from Linda Vista Road in order to enter campus. Proceed through the service entrance on your left-hand side in front of Manchester Village.
- Park temporarily in the reserved spots around the entrance to Manchester Village.
- Report to the check-in table at Manchester Village to receive your Transfer Fall Orientation materials and your housing information to check in to your room.

Step 2

- Proceed to the Alcalá Vistas Apartments by following Torero Way up the hill.
- At the top of the hill, you will reach a stop sign.
- Turn right for Palomar and Cuyamaca Halls.
- Turn left for Borrego and Laguna Halls.
- Park your vehicle in the areas surrounding your assigned hall. Volunteers will help unload your vehicle and move your items to your residence hall room.

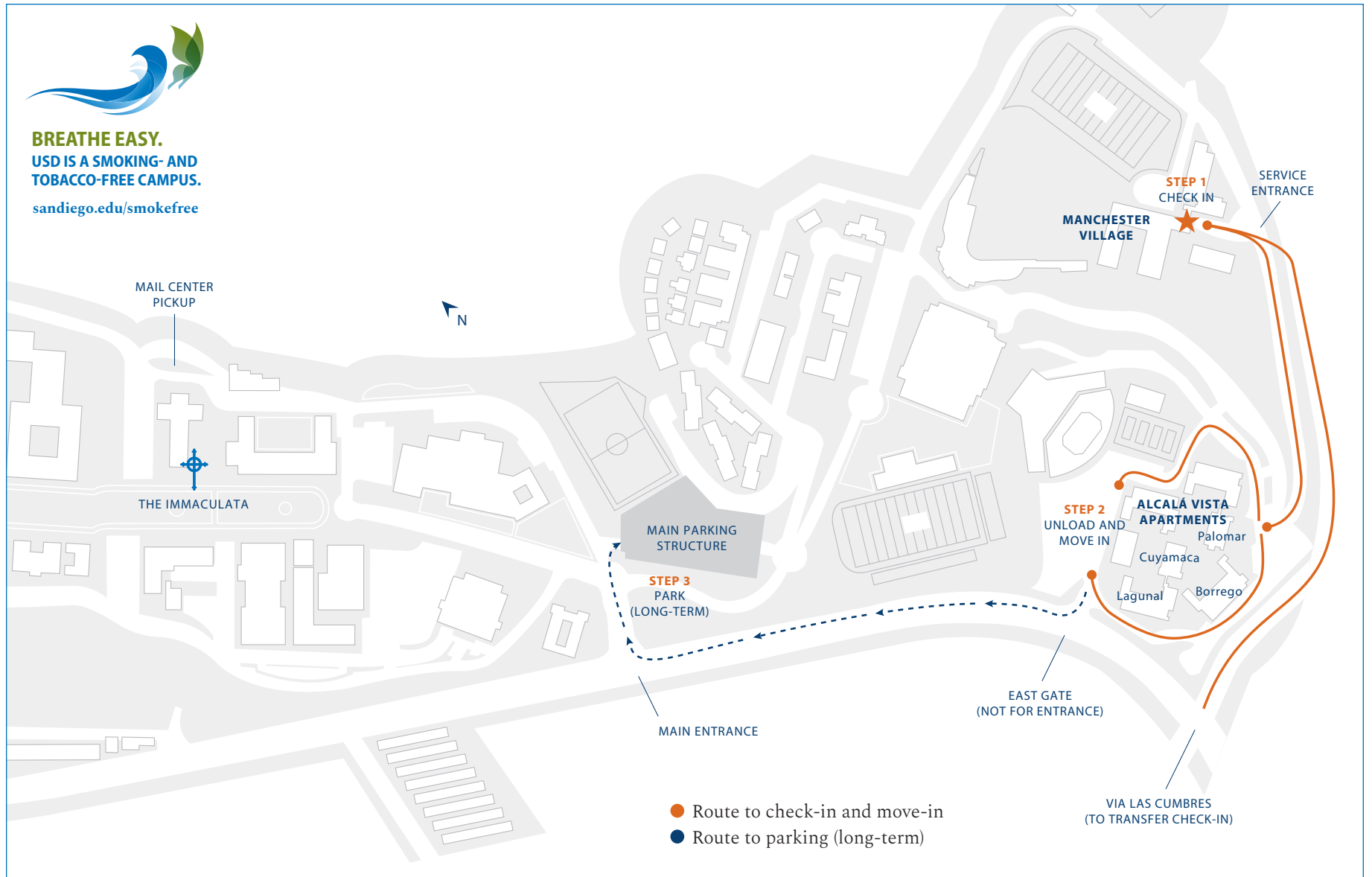
Step 3

- Long-term parking during Transfer Fall Orientation for Alcalá Vistas residents is located in the surface lots immediately around Laguna, Palomar, Borrego and Cuyamaca halls. Vehicles may also be parked in the Main Parking Structure or West Structure as needed during Transfer Fall Orientation.
- A resource desk will be located in Palomar Hall to assist you.

UNIVERSITY TERRACE APARTMENTS MOVE-IN

University Terrace (UTAs)

Step 1

- Turn north on Via Las Cumbres from Linda Vista Road in order to enter campus. Proceed through the service entrance in front of Manchester Village.
- Park temporarily in the reserved spots around the entrance to Manchester Village.
- Report to the check-in table at Manchester Village to receive your Transfer Fall Orientation materials and your housing information to check in to your room.

Step 2

- Proceed to the University Terrace Apartments by following Torero Way up the hill.
- Go left when you reach the stop sign on the top of the hill. Proceed around the Alcalá Vistas Apartments to the East Entrance of campus.
- Go right onto Linda Vista Road and forward through the traffic light at the Main Entrance. Turn left onto Goshen Street (first left past the Main Entrance).
- The University Terrace Apartments will be on your left.

Step 3

- Safely park your car on Goshen Street, Mildred Street, or in the small parking lot directly behind the University Terrace Apartments. Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings.
- A resource desk will be located in front of UTA 1347A to answer questions and provide you with assistance.
- Long-term parking during Transfer Fall Orientation for University Terrace residents is located in the Main Parking Structure. The Main Parking Structure is located in the center of campus and is adjacent to the Main Entrance. The University Terrace Apartments has a very small parking lot behind it. The Main Parking Structure is in close proximity to the University Terrace residence hall area by crossing Linda Vista Road.
