

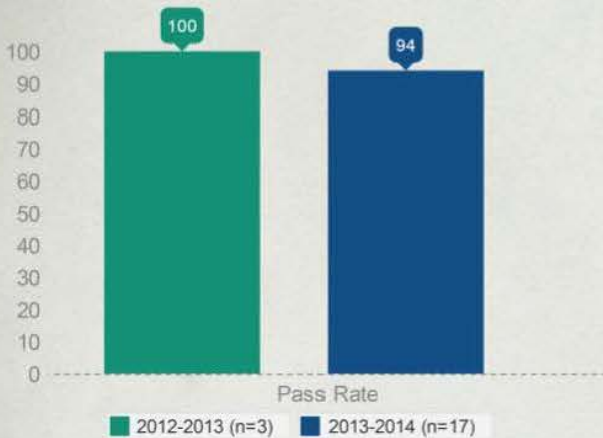

Mild to Moderate Education Specialist Credential Candidates' Who Successfully Passed Practicum on First Attempt



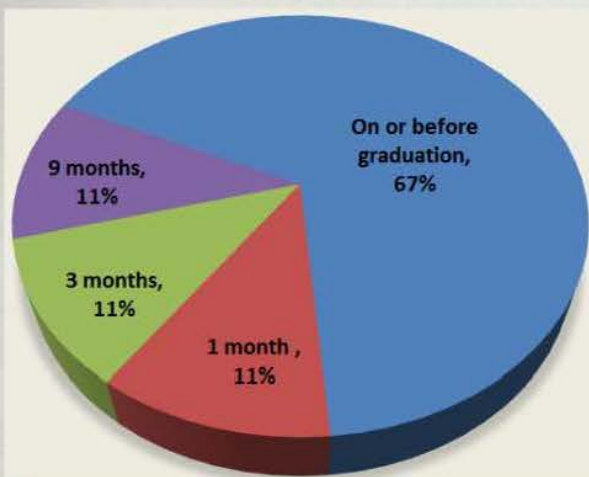
2013 to 2014 Retention Rate



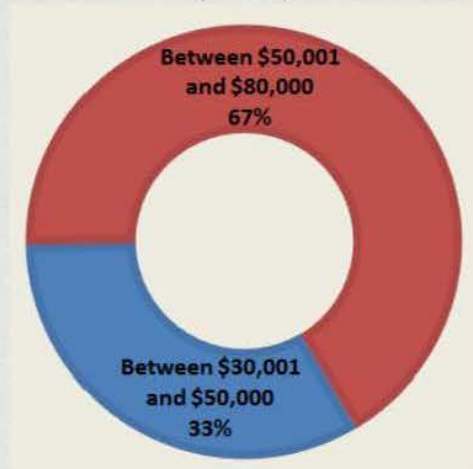
2014 Graduates Felt the Program Provided Good Career Preparation **100% (8 out of 8)**
