**SASC Graduate Assistants can earn a maximum of \$12,750 (pre-tax) per fiscal year for a total of two years through hourly wages paid through their assistantship. This is in addition to the \$5,000 per semester SASC scholarship which posts directly to graduate assistants' student accounts for a maximum of four semesters.
