

Beach Water Quality Indicator

Selected Beaches 2018

This map of the San Diego Coast shows the number of Advisories and Closures in Beach Mile days of 2018. Carlsbad, Solana Beach, and Del Mar had zero advisories and closures. The cities with two advisories and beach closures include Encinitas, San Diego (Torrey Pines), and San Diego (La Jolla). Ocean Beach and Point Loma in San Diego had four advisories and closures and Mission Bay in San Diego had six. Coronado had 20 advisories and closures and Imperial Beach had 51. With the highest number of advisories and closure, Border Field State Park/Tijuana Slough had 236.

Carlsbad and Solana Beach had the best water quality among San Diego County beaches in 2018. While overall water quality improved from 2017 levels, the Border Field State Park/Tijuana Slough National Shoreline had a concerning 236 Beach Mile Days of advisories and closures, largely due to impacts from the Tijuana River.
