Associated Students Fee

Facility Fee - Wellness Center

Benefits: The three-story, 80,000 square-foot facility will provide accessible indoor and outdoor spaces where the entire campus community can find connections between physical activity, diet and nutrition, mental health, inner self, engagement and belonging.

Features include:

- Dedicated areas for fitness, wellness and athletics
- Flexible rooms for exercise and health-related classes of every kind
- Advanced strength training and cardio equipment
- Counseling services and care advocate offices
- A teaching kitchen for healthy diet and nutrition programs
- Informal meeting and recreation spaces available to the entire campus community

Student Life Pavilion Fee

Benefits: The Student Life Pavilion Fee provides spaces for student government, student organizations including fraternity and sorority life, the Changemaker Hub, Black Student Resource Commons, LGBTQ+Allies Student Commons, United Front Multicultural Commons, Women’s Commons, graduate and law students and student media. It has become the hub of campus life, a central gathering place for fostering a sense of community among graduate, undergraduate and law students, faculty and staff.
