

Rainbow Educator Advisory Team

The purpose of the Rainbow Educator Advisory Team (REAT) is to assist the United Front Multicultural Center (UFMC) Director and Associate Director on program planning and development that supports the purpose of both the RE program and the UFMC. REAT members are appointed based on recommendations from the REAT and the UFMC Associate Director. They serve annual terms with option for reappointment.

The REAT consists of USD community stakeholders who are invested in the success of the RE program. The advisory team will intentionally represent the diversity of USD members served by the RE program. The structure of the team is as follows:

- 1 RE Faculty Member
- 1 Faculty Member (may or may not be an RE)
- 1 RE Student Affairs Administrator/Staff
- 1 USD Administrator/Staff (Student Affairs or other)
- 1 RE Graduate Student
- 1 RE Undergraduate Student
- 1 USD or RE alumni (to attend bi-annually during the goal review sessions)
- UFMC Associate Director to serve as REAT Chair

Responsibilities of the REAT include:

- Promote the RE purpose and services
- Enhance the public standing of the RE program as a campus resource
- Provide a voice from the roles they serve as a USD member
- Assist in developing annual goals and review progress
- Ensure RE program's components are aligned with the UFMC and RE purpose
- Seek best practices to be considered in program development
- Contribute to the on-going assessment of all program's components
- Collaborate in the RE on-going education development
- Recruit, train, and assess RE Team's performance
- Actively participate in REAT biweekly meetings
