



Recording and Publishing Video with your iPad


Step 1 - Make sure you are on wi-fi and connected to the internet.




Step 2 - Film with iPad by selecting the “Camera” icon.



Step 3 - Hit the “Record” button on the right.




Your videos will be saved to the “Camera Roll” under the Camera icon.





Step 4 - Open up YouTube Capture App. If you don't have the app, you can download it from the App Store.



Step 5 - Select the video you want to edit from the list.




Step 6 - Add title and description. Set privacy to unlisted and click “Upload.”



Before uploading, you can edit the video as needed by cutting out unwanted content at the beginning or end. You can also add music, correct the color and stabilize the video if it came out shaky.

Step 7 - The app will show the video is being uploaded to your YouTube account.



Step 8 - The video is now online and you can copy the unlisted link to Blackboard.
